## This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students achieving Upper 2 Bands in NAPLAN Writing to 20% in Year 3.
- Increase the percentage of students achieving Upper 2 Bands in NAPLAN Writing to 20% in Year 5.
- Increase our school's Mean Scale Score in Year 3 and Year 5 NAPLAN Writing.
- Increase percentages of students receiving A and B on their report card in English and Mathematics.
- Decrease the numbers of students receiving D or E on their report card in English and Mathematics, validated through moderation and grading calibration.
- Increase in the percentage of uncommon word usage in student writing samples from Term 1 to Term 4.
- Refine teacher practice in teaching writing from Term 1 to Term 4 as measured by school's Proficiency Scales aligned to the Australian Curriculum.
- Refine and calibrate quality teaching responses to the data presented in writing samples and classroom lessons.
- Increase student expertise in writing from Term 1 to Term 4 as demonstrated in writing samples – quick writes, narrative and persuasive texts.
- Increase students' proficiency as monitored through school-developed writing proficiency scales.
- Increase in consistency of schoolwide use of agreed writing pedagogies – Oral Language Approach to Writing.

## Our initiatives include

- Develop a whole school, research-based methodology to writing based on the 6 +1 Traits of Writing within the school's oral language approach.
- Develop teacher knowledge and understanding of the P-10 Australian Curriculum content descriptions and achievement standards by designing and supporting processes for robust intra-school and inter-school moderation.
- Provide targeted professional development and coaching to deepen teachers' understanding of writing and associated pedagogies.
- Provide targeted professional development and coaching to increase teachers' capability and competence in responding to student data and planning appropriate actions.
- Provide increased teacher aide time to support differentiated instruction within the writing process in classrooms.
- Targeted planning day – focus on writing.
- Author in Residence.
- Maintain school processes and support structures enacted by the Positive Behaviour for Learning team from Tier 1 to Tier 2 and Tier 3.
- Continue to provide classroom profiling for all teachers to support their professional learning.
- Support the school's involvement in the regional number facts initiative in selected classrooms.
- State the improvement initiatives.
- State the evidence-base that supports your approach to school improvement.
